ORDER:

In The G.O. first read above, orders were issued enhancing the powers delegated to various District Revenue Officials in the matter of assignment / lease of Government lands. In the above order, the monetary limits of District Revenue Officials for Assignment of cultivable land and assignment of house sites are as follows:

2. Due to enormous rise in the land value during the past 10 years, the Principal Secretary and Commissioner of Land Administration was requested to send proposal to revise the existing monetary powers of District Revenue Officials for the assignment of the land:

3. In the letter second read above, the Principal Secretary and Commissioner of Land Administration has stated that the orders issued by the Government in the year 1999 has not been revised for the last 10 years and that due to steep increase in the land value, the monetary powers of various officers in the matter of assignment / lease needs to be revised and has therefore requested that the monetary powers delegated to the various Revenue Officials in grant of assignment may be revised as follows:-

4. The Government after careful examination accept the proposals of the Principal Secretary and Commissioner of Land Administration and revise the monetary powers delegated to various Revenue Officials in grant of assignment of Government lands as follows:-
